#### **1. Skradin (Croatia)**

Skradin is located in the Sibenik-Knin County. It is a smaller town area. On the east and south, towards the territory of the neighboring Promina (Oklaj) municipality as well as the towns of Drnis and Sibenik, it borders with the River Krka and the Lakes Visovacko and Prukljansko which in reality represent submerged broadenings of the River Krka valley.



Skradin is a romantic Mediterranean town with narrow paved streets, passages, vaults and stairs. The entire town core represents a protected cultural monument. It contains houses dating from the 18th and 19th century which are stuccoed in the manner typical for Venice and areas under her influence. On the streets of Skradin you will find the pleasant atmosphere of a small Dalmatian town, especially during the Skradin festival of klapa singing (a capella singing typical for the Croatian Adriatic) or during the celebration of the Nativity of the Virgin Mary.

When speaking about the 6000 year long existence of the Skradin area, historians endowed with wisdom search for the reasons of that continuity in its location and geo-strategic position. In the peace and quiet of the Visovac monastery and the burst of water drops of the Skradinski Buk waterfall. In each moment of enjoyment of food which has skilfully managed to escape both fridges and freezers which would rob it of its natural aromas and has arrived thoroughly fresh at your table. Such is Skradin, small, picturesque and filled with flavour, found at a point where the river passionately embraces the sea.

## 3. Hotel in Skradin

Hotel „Skradinski buk“ is located in the historical town of Skradin, named after the world famous waterfall on the Krka river, Skradinski Buk. Hotel Skradinski buk is perfectly situated to allow for numerous excursions to nearby national parks and other sites of interest in Šibenik-Knin county. The city of Skradin is the official entrance (by boat) to Krka National Park, while the hotel is only 300 meters away from the dock. The purchase of an entrance ticket to the park includes a complimentary boat ride from Skradin to the waterfall.

Hotel Skradinski Buk, surrounded by pristine nature, magnificent waterfalls «Krka» and a rich cultural heritage, offers you accommodation in completely renovated and refurbished rooms. The hotel terrace can accommodate 200 guests to enjoy the Dalmatian atmosphere, live music and domestic specialties, such as wine, and fruit (žičule), rose and walnut brandies.
